Ageing Population

- In 1950 people lived on average to 77 & 79; now it is 83 & 86 and increasing
- Life expectancy is higher in rural than urban areas
- Rural areas are ageing at a faster rate than urban areas
- Braintree district has one of the largest projected ageing growth rates in the UK

Climate Change

Climate Change

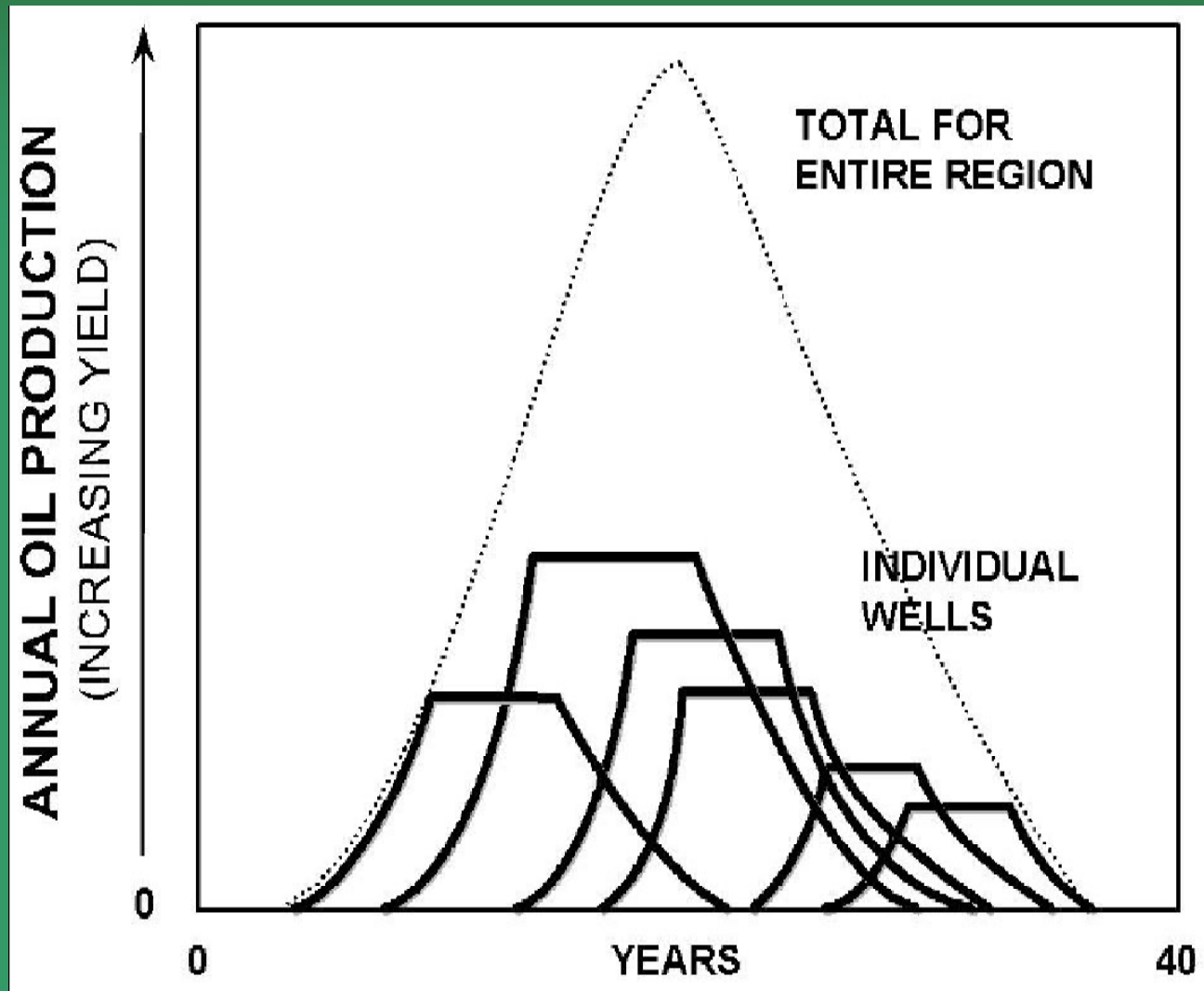
- Extreme weather conditions

Energy Supplies

'Peak Oil' is the point when worldwide production of conventional crude oil peaks in volume, after which the rate of production enters terminal decline.

The concept is based on the observed production rates of individual oil wells, and the combined production rate of a field of related oil wells.
